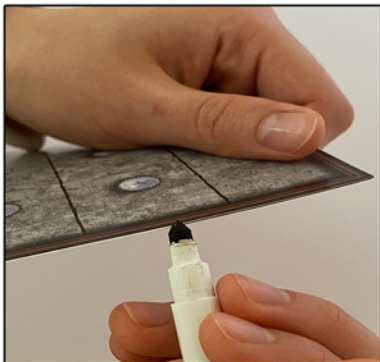


STEP 1 - Collect the correct tools.

For best results, we suggest you gather at least the most basic tools you will need to complete assembly. While you may find more tools that will help you achieve outstanding results, we suggest you start with the following: Hot glue gun, scissors, variety of water based colored markers, tweezers, straight edge rulers, hobby knife, instant setting high strength hobby glue.



STEP 2 - Empty contents of the kit, and carefully cut out all the individual parts to be assembled. Please note that the most precise cuts you can make will result in a dramatically better looking finished project.



STEP 3 - With appropriate color markers, detail the edges of all the parts you cut out. This will result in a finely finished project once assembled.

STEP 4 - **Scoring.** Using a scoring tool (see picture) and a straight-edge ruler, apply pressure onto the surface of the part you wish to bend, on top of a line you want to fold. This is called scoring. Scoring along lines to be bent makes bending all printed parts easier, and results in a much cleaner looking fold. Bend parts using the length of your straightedge ruler. Scoring is an essential skill.

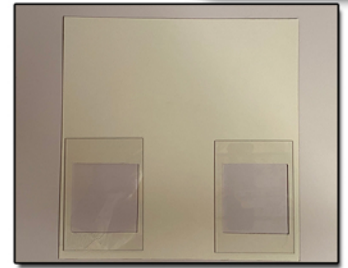




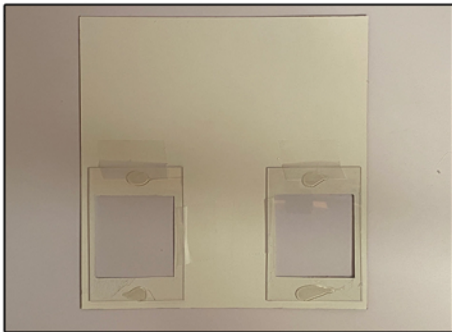
STEP 5 - With scale building kits, there is usually no correct place to begin. In this case, let's start with the Front Coffee Shop Wall Windows. Carefully cut out the inside of the two front windows while avoiding the white window frames. Use a



STEP 6 - When cutting the inside of the front windows, I recommend using a semi clear ruler, so you can see the white window frame behind the ruler. Putting a ruler on top of the window frame, it protects the paper while cutting the inside of the window out. After the inside of the window is out the Front wall should look like this.



Step 7 - Now that the inside of the windows are out, I recommend putting on plastic gloves to avoid finger prints on the glass included the kit. Carefully take off the plastic wrapping on both sides of the glass. Then Flip the Front Wall so that the white side is facing you. And place both glass pieces on top of the window openings evenly. Like shown above.



STEP 8 - After the Front wall is flipped with the evenly placed glass on top of the white side window openings, place a small amount of hot glue behind the glass against the wall, or you can simply just tape the window glass on too. It should look something like this after securing the glass on to the wall.



STEP 9 - Now that the glass is secure on to the front coffee shop wall, we can assemble the Front Window illusion rooms. Score and Fold the side walls of the illusion rooms, fold inward. Score and fold the Glue tabs on the illusion Rooms outward. It should look something like this.



STEP 10 - When done scoring and folding the illusion rooms, place the correct illusion room on to the correct side. Place directly on top of the window openings/glass on the white side. You can flip the wall the other side with the illusion room to make sure its fully covering the window before gluing. After place a small amount of hot glue on both glue tabs then secure on to the wall.



Step 11 - This step is optional. In the kit, AJ's Coffee Shop and Fresh Coffee Stickers are included. These are for the front windows when done assembling. You can place any sticker on to the glass window to appear more realistic. For an example the windows would look something like this if stickers are applied.



Step 12 - Now that we have the front coffee shop wall all assembled, glue front wall on to the front of the base. Line up evenly. Place a few small globs of hot glue behind the wall while holding it straight until dry. Then after Score and Fold Side wall glue tabs, glue the side walls on to the correct side, then on to the front wall.



Step 13 - After side walls are secure with the front wall, glue the back wall on, I recommend gluing the back wall on to the side wall glue tabs one at a time to get it very straight and even with hot glue. After you can add small amounts of hot glue between the walls if not perfectly together, hold until dry. Then after all walls are assembled glue or place the roof on top evenly on all sides.



STEP 14 - Now that the whole building is completed, let's assemble the drive thru sign. Glue both sides of the drive thru sign pole together so that both sides is gray. Then glue drive thru pole on to the white side of either drive thru sign side. After glue the other drive thru sign side so the pole is between the sign. Like shown above.



STEP 17 - Now let's assemble the Coffee Shop Sign. This sign will make the building look more complete. Cut out the sign connector, score and fold carefully. Next glue the tabs of the sign connector together, so its a 3D rectangle. use very small amounts of hot glue when connecting, hold until dry. Now cut out the Pop out signs. Cut out the Round Sign Edge too, Curl the Round Sign Edge on a sharp table or desk edge by cutting out and pulling on desk edge to get a uniform curl started.



STEP 20 - Last, theres an optional 3D AJS Coffee Shop Sign. On the right side wall, there is already a sign placement, place small amount of hot glue on to 3D sign, place directly on top of the sign on right side wall for a 3D affect.



STEP 15 - Next you can add optional black and white striped awnings on the front and side windows. Score and fold the white line between the black tab and the awning. Then fold both downward. Place a small amount of hot or white glue to the black tab, and place near the top of the white window frames, like shown above.



STEP 18 - After grab one of the pop out signs, flip it so the white side is facing you. then grab the Round Sign edge, wrap the Round Sign Edge around the pop out sign (make sure the white side of the Round Sign edge is facing the inside, and the sliver part is facing the outside) then adding very small globs of hot glue slowly around the sign one by one behind the white part of the Round Sign Edge against the pop out sign connecting them together. Add another drop of hot glue when the other glob is dry until ends of the Round Sign Edge meet. There will be extra Round Sign Edge, so cut a little off, so theres not much overlapping. Then glue the Round Sign Edge together



STEP 16 - There are also optional front window tables. After cutting out the table top out, cut off 1/4 of the table top straight off, so one end is a flat edge. Then grab the black straw included, cut off a piece about 3/8 of an inch of black straw for the bottom of the table. Then place a small amount of hot glue underneath the middle of the table top. Place the 3/8 inch of black straw on to the glue, hold until dry. place/glue directly against the front window. you can make up to 3 table tops if wanted.



STEP 19- Now that the Round Sign Edge and one of the sides of the pop out sign are together, I recommend gluing the sign connector on before putting the other side of the pop out sign to avoid putting the logo in different directions. When gluing the sign connector on to the sign, glue against the Round Sign Edge with the logo parallel to the connector. Then glue on to the building, preferably on the left side of the building right next to the upper windows, like shown above in STEP 18. Then after thats on the building ,place small amounts of hot or white glue around the inside of the other pop out sign, make sure the logo is in the correct direction, upwards before gluing. And glue on to the rest of the sign.



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Carefully cut out everything with a good scissors, taking long even strokes.

Keep sharp tools away from children.
Scissors and exacto knife and blades
