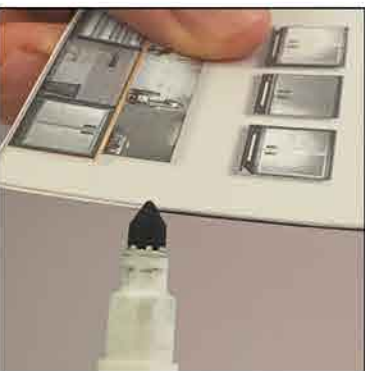

STEP 1 - Collect the correct tools. For best results, we suggest you gather at least the most basic tools you will need to complete assembly. While you may find more tools that will help you achieve outstanding results, we suggest you start with the following: Hot glue gun, scissors, variety of water based colored markers, tweezers, straight edge rulers, hobby knife, instant setting high strength hobby glue.

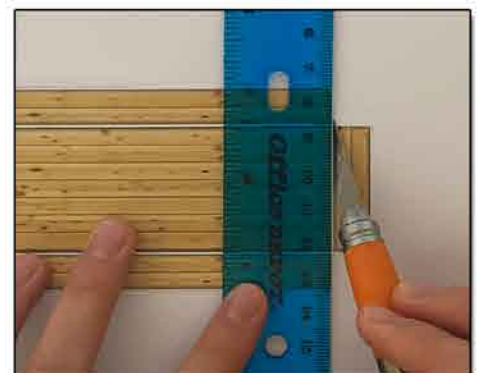


STEP 2 - Empty contents of the kit, and carefully cut out all the individual parts to be assembled. Please note that the most precise cuts you can make will result in a dramatically better looking finished project.



STEP 3 - With appropriate color markers, detail the edges of all the parts you cut out. This will result in a finely finished project once assembled.

STEP 4 - Scoring. Using a scoring tool (see picture) and a straight-edge ruler, apply pressure onto the surface of the part you wish to bend, on top of a line you want to fold. This is called scoring. Scoring along lines to be bent makes bending all printed parts easier, and results in a much cleaner looking fold. Bend parts using the length of your straightedge ruler. Scoring is an essential skill.



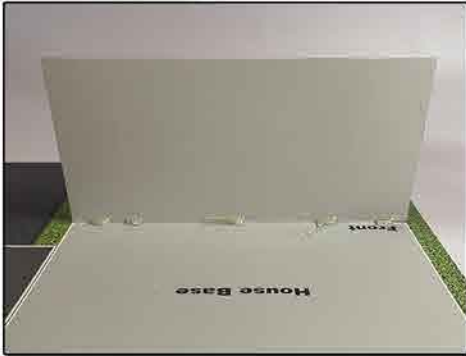


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STEP 5 - With scale building kits, there is usually no correct place to begin. In this case, will start with the front of the house. Glue down the Front Wall, when gluing, line up the wall perfectly before, then place two small amounts of hot glue behind the wall. Hold in to place until dry.



STEP 6 - Next cut out the House Porch, Score and Fold the white lines on the porch, fold the porch tabs downward to create sides. Glue the porch sides together. Fold them so there touching, and place a small amount of hot glue in each corner (inside of it) white part. Hold until dry.



Step 7 - After the Porch is assembled and glued in place, cut out the Porch Pillars. Score and Fold each side. Then glue. After gluing. Place each pillar on each front end side of the Porch. Like shown above.



STEP 8 - Now that the pillars are in place. Grab the Second Level Triangle Wall. Score between the triangle white trim and the porch ceiling. Then Fold, When folding the triangle wall should be straight up, and the porch flat down, 90 degrees from each other. After Score glue tab. Fold downward. Like shown above.



STEP 9 - Glue the Glue tab on the Second Level Triangle Wall on to the inside of the Front wall, while lining up with the wall evenly. After, place a small amount of glue on top of the pillars, press down gently on the porch ceiling to connect the pillars and ceiling.



STEP 10 - After gluing the Second Level Triangle wall, lets assemble the side walls, Score and Fold the Glue Tabs on both sides of the walls. After glue them to the front wall. Then after the Side walls are attached, glue on the back wall carefully. You can add a small amount of hot glue behind the walls while holding on to until dry for better support.



Step 11 - Now that the house walls are together, lets add the Car Port. First score and fold the walls/glue tabs. After Glue on the inside Car Port illusion rooms on to the correct sides. When gluing, make sure the Car Port white side is facing you. Line up the Illusion rooms ends with the ends of the Port walls. Like shown above.



Step 12 - Then glue Car port in place, carefully lining it up with the base. Fold the Front Wall Car Port Glue tabs(on the bottom) fold inward for better support when gluing. After it should look like this. Now you can look inside your carport!



Step 13 - After assembling all the walls and Car Port, you can finally add the Correct Roofs. Score and Fold the small white line between the roofs. Also the Car port roof, Left side of roof is smaller than the right so it fit next to the house.
